Interestingly enough, the Blacks appear quite well dressed and happy and are posed along with the Whites. Most of the photos are of people in pairs and groups. In some photos the males and one female are posed in uniforms similar to that used by the Boers. Many Afrikaners were exiled to Argentina from 1902 to 1906. There are similarities between the Patagonian plains and the South African "Karos" which permitted their adaption. Both are lands of scarce vegetation and water as is evident in the photos.
There is an interesting book on the Boer exile to Southern Argentina which was consulted- EN LA TIERRA DEL VIENTO...ULTIMA TRAVESIA BOER 1902-2002 by Liliana Esther Peralta and Maria Lauro Moron, published in Comodoro Rivadavia, Chubut, Argentina in 2002 which is included with the album. The book has photographs but only one of them depicts a black person-a hottentot.
600 Afrikaners came to Argentina and over half were repatriated in the 1930's.
